Warwickshire residents donate £650 to The Shakespeare Hospice

A local waste reduction scheme has rewarded top-performing residents with a £650 donation to support a local hospice.

Stratford-Upon-Avon residents using the Slim Your Bin programme chose to donate £650 to The Shakespeare Hospice after winning the community competition. Slim Your Bin - a partnership programme between Jump and Warwickshire County Council - rewards participants for reducing their waste and increasing recycling with individual prizes for residents each month and a charity donation every year.

The donation made to The Shakespeare Hospice will help to ensure continued care for people with life limiting illnesses and their families.



In 2021, Slim Your Bin participants recorded over 23,000 positive environmental actions. These actions include pledging to reduce single-use plastic, buying second hand or taking part in a litter pick.

In total, £3,250 has been donated to charities across Warwickshire since Slim Your Bin began. Slim Your Bin is provided by Jump, the leading supplier of sustainability and wellbeing engagement programmes in the UK.
