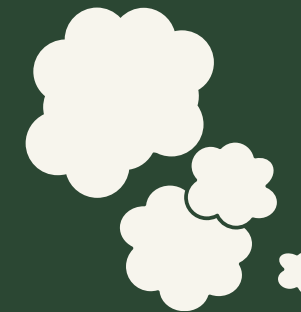

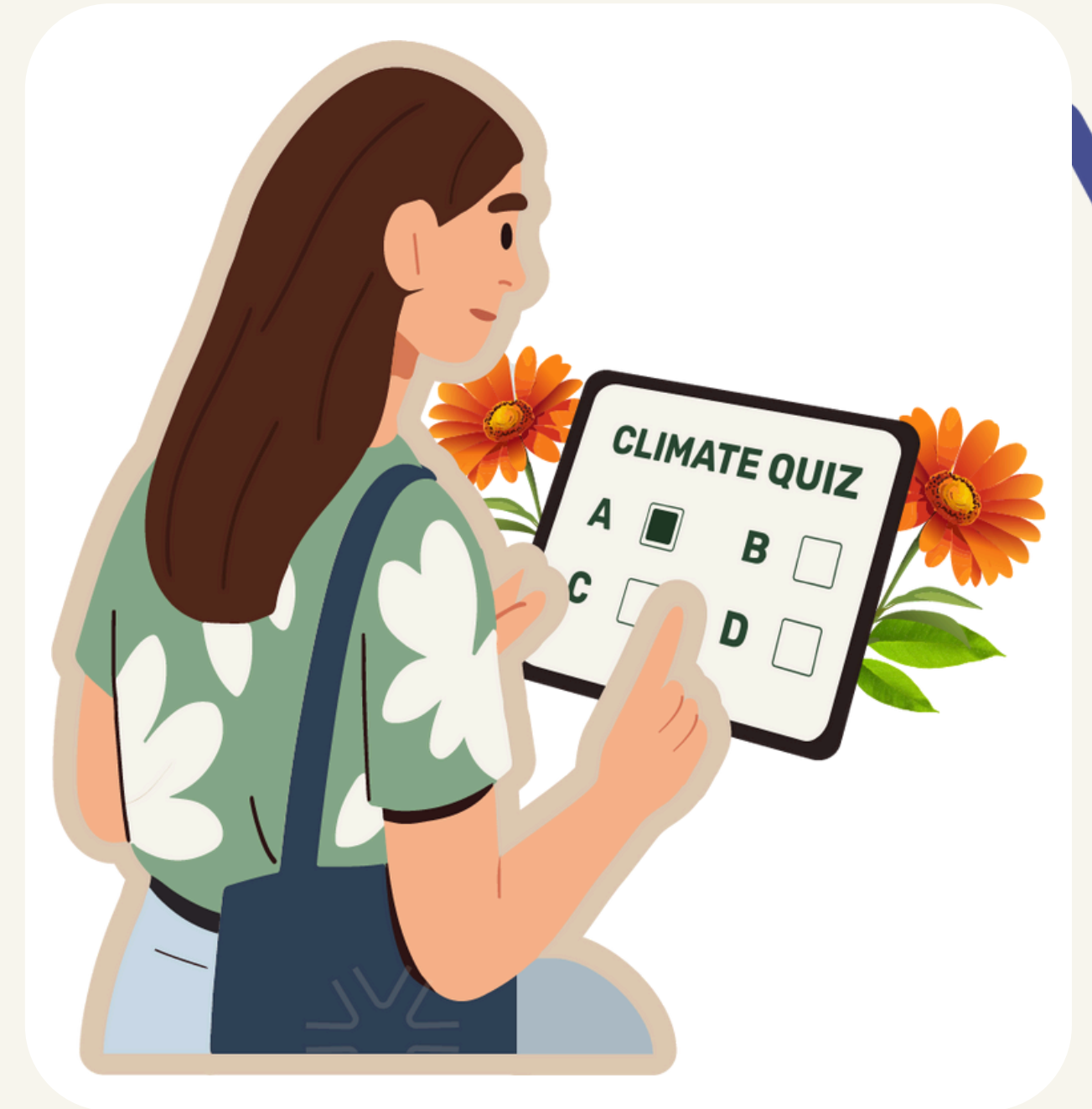

Annual Member's Survey

In 2025, we surveyed 1,605 of our programme members on their sustainable behaviours since using a Team Jump platform. Here are our findings:

- 79% of members are more conscious of their energy usage and how to reduce it.
- 84% of members are more aware of their consumption and have taken steps to change.
- 95% of members understand more about the impact of their actions on the environment.
- 95% of members said that sustainability actions have become part of their routine.

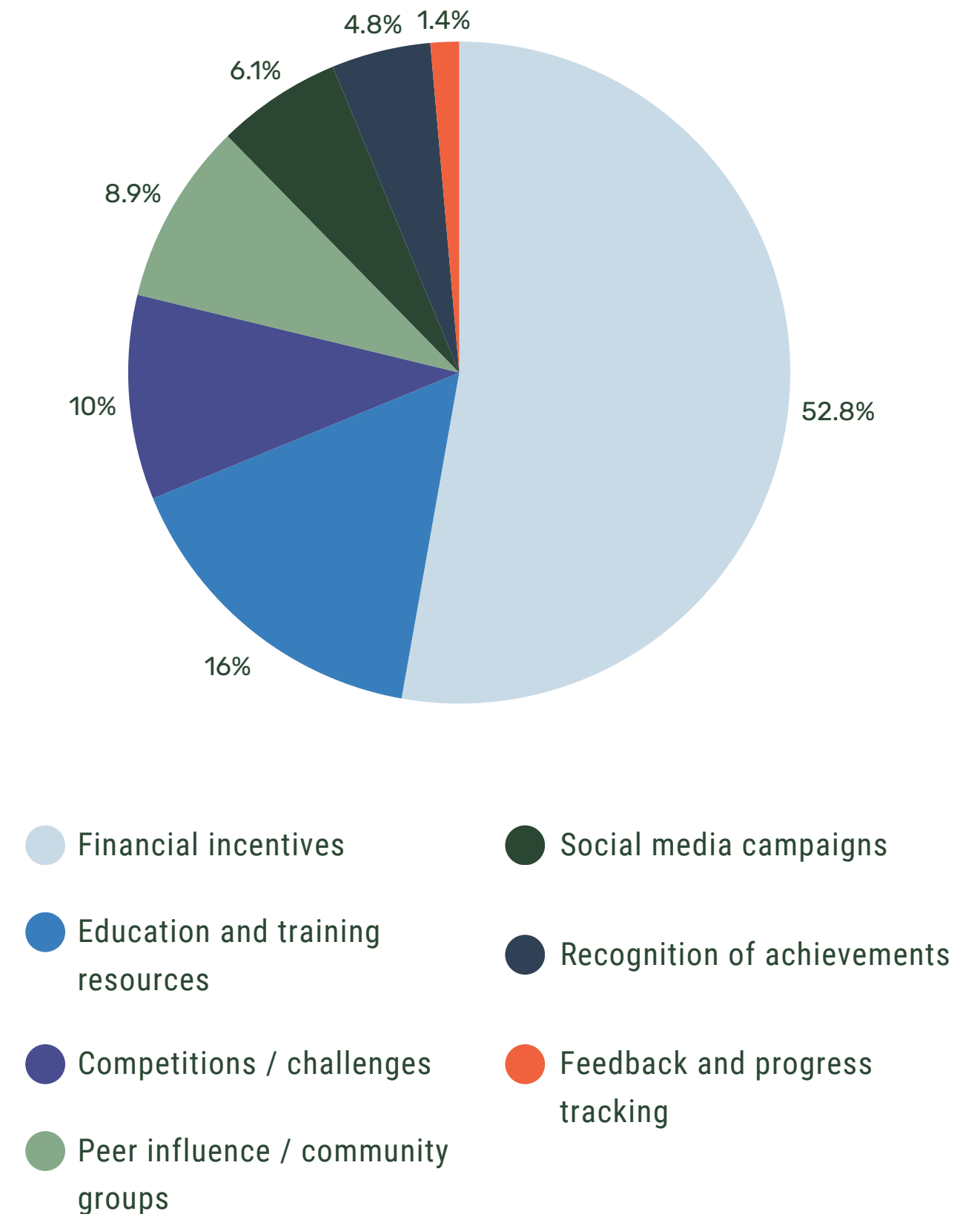

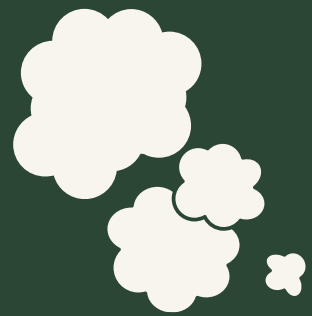
We also used insights from our member's survey to create our whitepaper, [Sustainability Engagement Trends 2026](#). This survey highlighted:

- 75% of green champions believe that not enough people are taking action to prevent and slow down climate change.
- 32% of respondents said it was their own moral or ethical responsibility
- Our survey showed that 73% of members listed competing priorities as a barrier to climate action
- 53% of respondents ranked financial incentives as the most effective motivator.

Highlight: Mindful Tech Challenge

One of our campaigns this year focused on educating members on the environmental impact of AI, data storage and electronic waste and incentivising adoption of more sustainable behaviours.

Lasting 3 months, actions logged during the Mindful Tech Challenge avoided a total of 44,000 kg CO₂e and saw us launch an enhanced gamified eLearning feature with excellent results.

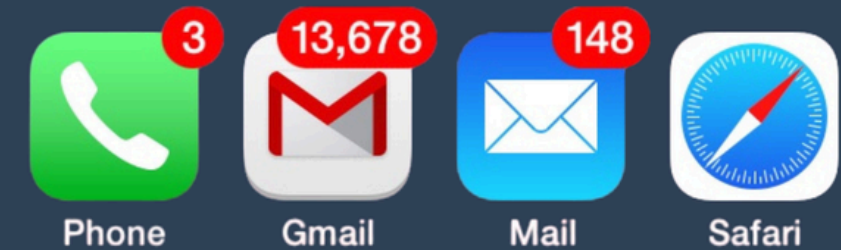
In a post-campaign survey, members reported the following:

- 96% changed how they use digital tools to reduce their impact
- 94% were more mindful of electronics care, recycling and disposal
- 95% increased their knowledge about AI and electronic waste.
- 94% agreed the eLearning module was an effective way to learn.

Global data centres combined now use more electricity than the UK!

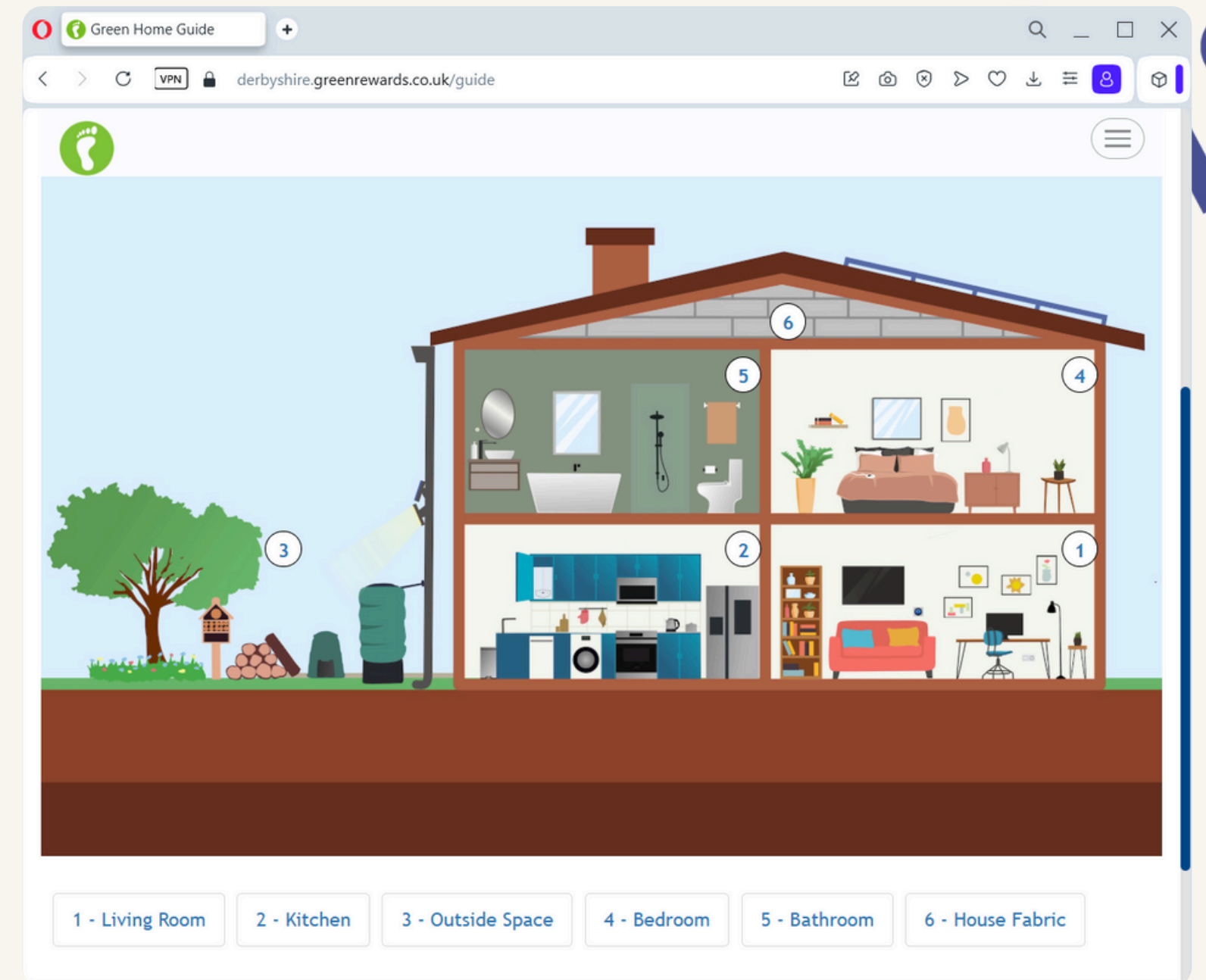


Highlight: Green Home Guide

In 2025, we collaborated with Derby City, Derbyshire Dales, Broxtowe Borough Council, Nottingham City and Midlands Net Zero Hub to launch a gamified eLearning feature, funded by Innovate UK.

This module, titled the **Green Home Guide**, supports residents to reduce the environmental impact of their homes and reduce costs through actionable guidance.

Residents earn points for clicking through various areas of a digital house, learning practical sustainability tips such as insulation guidance and water-saving habits, and testing their knowledge through interactive quizzes and games.

“The prize vouchers are a fab incentive for staff to get involved, particularly for more demanding behaviours such as cycling to work. The carbon calculator is a great tool to work out our individual impact at work and home.

We've recently hit the milestone of signing up 10% of our full-time workforce, and in the last twelve months, these members completed over 20,000 actions, reducing CO₂ emissions by a whopping 120,000 kilograms, the approximate emissions of driving 886,000 kilometers!
